## Why in news?

Two engineers from India win 35<sup>th</sup> annual Ig Nobel Prize awards for engineering design.

- **Aim-** The Ig Nobel Prizes are intended to celebrate the unusual, honor the imaginative and stimulate people's interest in science, medicine, and technology.
- It is awarded annually.
- Created in 1991 by Marc Abrahams, editor of the science humor magazine *Annals of Improbable Research (AIR)*.
- Motto "First make people laugh, and then make them think".
- Organized by The scientific humor magazine "<u>Annals of Improbable</u> <u>Research (AIR)"</u>
- Categories <u>10 prizes</u> are awarded in many categories Physics, chemistry, physiology/medicine, literature, economics, peace, public health, engineering, biology, and interdisciplinary research.
- The 2025 ceremony, *held virtually* from Harvard University's Sanders Theatre, USA.
- Ig Nobel prize, 2025 In <u>engineering design</u> category <u>Vikash</u> Kumar and Sarthak Mittal (22<sup>nd</sup> for India).
  - Reason For analyzing, from an engineering design perspective, how foul-smelling shoes affect the good experience of using a shoerack.
- In 2022 An international team from India, China, Malaysia, and the US won the <u>mechanical engineering prize</u> "for re-animating dead spiders to use as mechanical gripping tools".
- In 2020 *India and Pakistan* had shared the *peace prize* "for having their diplomats surreptitiously ring each other's doorbells in the middle of the night, and then run away before anyone had a chance to answer the door".
