- **Pakistan** The Trump administration is increasingly implying its hard-line approach on Pakistan's support for terrorism.
- \bullet This gains significance when India is trying to convey to the world the role of Pakistan as a state sponsor of terror. \n
- The US's proposed aims in Afghanistan is also significantly shaping the convergence between India and US.
- **South-Asia** New alignments are emerging with India and the U.S. expanding its military cooperation in the Indo-Pacific region.
- Unlike in the past, India is more actively involved in East and Southeast Asia as part of its 'Act East' policy.
- \bullet Given the role of China in the Indo-Pacific region, US is also encouraging India to shore up its presence in the South Asian region. \n
- **Defence** The US Defence Secretary hinted at sharing some of the US's most advanced defence technologies with India.
- This is expected to further deepen the defence trade and technology

collaboration between the defence industries of both the countries.

- \bullet The sale of 22 Sea Guardian Unmanned Aerial Systems announced during Modi's visit to the U.S. earlier this year, is high on the agenda. $\$
- With this, the Indian Navy is expected to acquire the world's most advanced maritime reconnaissance drone.
