Why in News?

Recently, Ministry of Education released the Performance Grading Index (PGI) 2.0 for 2025-26.

- **PGI** - It is a data-driven framework devised by the **Union Ministry of Education**.
- To evaluate the quality and effectiveness of school education systems across Indian States, Union Territories (UTs), and Districts.

PGI Framework

- **70 indicators grouped under 6 domains** -
 - Learning Outcomes
 - Access
 - Infrastructure & Facilities
 - Equity
 - Governance Processes
 - Teacher Education and Training
- **Purpose** - Categorises States/UTs into performance bands; multiple States can fall in same grade.
- **Utility** - Identifies gaps, guides policy reforms, promotes evidence-based governance in education.

Key Highlights

- **Chandigarh** - Top Performer (Uttam-3 grade, 761-820 points).
- **Delhi** - Placed in Prachesta-1 grade (701-760 points).
- **Meghalaya** - Score from 448 to 525.7, moved out of lowest grade.
- **Gap Reduction** - Performance difference among States reduced from 51% (2017-18) to 31.4% (2025-26).
