Peer-to-Peer Lending

- RBI has announced that Peer-to-peer lending (P2P) platforms will be treated as non-banking financial companies (NBFC) and will be regulated by it.

\n

- P2P lending is a form of crowd funding used to raise loans in an online platform which are paid back with interest.

\n

- Individuals or businesses can borrow money using an online platform which matches the lenders with borrowers.

\n

- P2P lending platforms are largely technology companies registered under the Companies Act that act as aggregators for lenders and borrowers.

- The interest rate may be set by the platform or by mutual agreement between the borrower and the lender.

- A quantum computer employs the principles of quantum mechanics to store information in 'qubits' instead of the typical binary bits of 1 and 0.

- Circuits are designed in such a way that qubits work faster and can do intensive computing task much faster than other computers.

- It solves the problem in the same way of computing physics which might never be possible on traditional computers.

- Canada's D-Wave Systems, is a pioneer in developing quantum computers.

Measuring height of Mount Everest

- The government of Nepal is finalizing a methodology to measure the height of Mount Everest.

- Already there are three different measures, in which two are determined by Indian survey and one by China.

\n

- In 1856, the Royal Surveyor of India has measured the height as 8,840 metres and again in 1955, an Indian survey measured as 8,848 metres.

- In 2005, China conducted its own survey and came up with a figure that is exactly between the two heights measured by the two Indian surveys.

- China claimed the peak's "rock height" that of naked rock, uncapped by snow is 8,844 m high, or 4 m less than the "snow height".
