- The ADB was modelled closely on the world bank and has a similar weighted voting system.

- Recent Decisions were made to expand ADB assistance to relatively lesser developed Indian states in the area of power (including renewable energy), transport, urban development, and health services.

- India's suggestion to set-up a regional hub in New Delhi for South Asia region was agreed by the ADB.
