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Since the maximum insolation is available in the equatorial region, the

earth's surface is intensely heated during the day so that the lowermost layers of air get warmed. The heated air expands, becomes lighter, and rises upward. Thus, convectional currents are set up in the atmosphere throughout the year. Convergence of air is the result of these convective currents. The converging air brings moisture from the tropics. Hence, the high humidity.
