

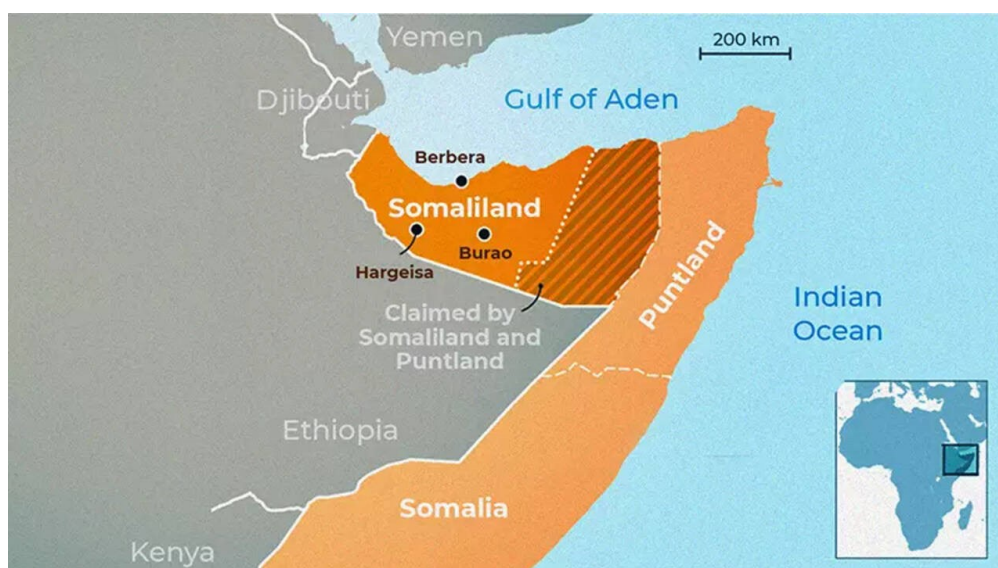
## Republic of Somaliland

*Prelims: Current events of national and international importance | International relations*

### Why in News?

Israel became the first United Nations (UN) member state to officially recognise the Republic of Somaliland as an independent and sovereign state.

- **Somaliland** - It is also known as the Republic of Somaliland, is a **self-declared republic** in the Horn of Africa, which is ***internationally recognised as part of Somalia***.
- **Capital** - Hargeisa (largest city).
- **Location** - Somaliland lies along the Gulf of Aden, a vital maritime trade route connecting the Red Sea to the Indian Ocean.
- **Borders** -
  - The Republic of Djibouti to the northwest,
  - Ethiopia to the south and west, and
  - The rest of Somalia (specifically the Puntland region) to the east, and
  - A significant coastline on the Gulf of Aden to the north.



- **Background** -
  - Somaliland gained independence from **Britain** on June 26, 1960.
  - Somaliland declared independence **from Somalia** in May 1991 following the Somali Civil War and has remained de facto independent ever since.
  - It has its own currency, passport, government, and military, but lacked

international recognition until now.

- **Timeline of Recognition**

- **Taiwan** - Becomes the first to recognise Somaliland in 2020,
  - **Ethiopia** - In 2024, it signed an MoU to explore formal recognition in exchange for naval base access.
  - **Israel** - In 2025, it becomes the first UN member state to officially recognise Somaliland as independent.
  - **Several other countries** - including the United Kingdom, the United Arab Emirates (UAE), Turkey, Denmark, and Kenya- have informal diplomatic relations with Somaliland.
- **Somalia's Position** - Somalia insists Somaliland is an inseparable part of its territory and condemned Israel's move as a "deliberate attack" on sovereignty.
  - **India's Position** - India has officially ***not recognised*** Somaliland as an independent and sovereign state.
