• People are not using toilets because they neither have access nor the capacity to use one.

• Organising campaigns to shame them into using toilets by appointing

whistle-blowers isn't the solution.

- Also, the mode of financing for the project has pushed those living on the margins into debt traps as costs are reimbursed after the construction.  $\n$
- Hence, the campaign on toilets has shown complete insensitivity and this needs to be tuned to address the issues at the grassroots.  $\n$

- To clean the country, understanding the problems of those who have spent a lifetime cleaning the country is necessary.  $\$
- Despite the Constitution declaring the abolition of untouchability, it is still practised by perpetuating occupations such as scavenging.  $\n$
