 - Museology and Tribal Museum Management
 - Tribal Arts and Crafts of India
 - Tribal Textiles

- **Learning Tools** - Integrated Learning Management System (LMS) and Repository Management System (RMS)
- **LMS** - It is a software application used to create, administer, deliver, and track educational courses and training programmes.
- **RMS** - It provides centralised storage and organisation for digital assets, source code, and build artefacts.

Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs)

- **Policy Think Tanks** - TRIs to act as centres of excellence for research, documentation, and policy support.
- **Workshop Outcomes** - The National TRI Roadmap was prepared; the Bhubaneswar Declaration was adopted for reforms, tech integration, and capacity building.
- **Technology Integration** - Use of AI, Geographic Information System (GIS), and digital tools for tribal research and governance.
