#### History, Art and Culture

##### Nazca Civilization

- 
- Located in** - Southern Peru, South America.
- 
- Created between** - 200 BC and 650 AD.
- 
- Nazca Lines** - It remains one of archaeology's greatest mysteries.
- 
- These enormous desert patterns *depict animals, plants, geometric shapes, and human figures*, visible only from the air.
- 
- Decades of study have yet to explain why the Nazca civilisation created these designs.
- 
- AI** - "Archaeologists use AI to uncover hidden Nazca geoglyphs; in 6 months, 303 new figures were found, nearly doubling known sites.
- 
- This marks a *3<sup>rd</sup> era of discovery* such as ancient builders, aircraft revealing scale, and now AI mapping the bigger picture."

##### Return of Thirumangai Alvar Statue

- 
- Origin** - Sundararaja Perumal Temple, Thanjavur district, Tamil Nadu.
- 
- Period** - 16<sup>th</sup> century bronze statue of Saint Thirumangai Alvar.
- 
- Acquisition by** - Ashmolean Museum, Oxford, in 1967 from private collector J.R.Belmont.
- 
- Discovery** - Independent French scholar linked the bronze to a 1957 photograph from the temple archives.
- 
- Return** - Ashmolean Museum returned the statue to the Government of India (High Commission in London) after detailed provenance research.

#### Geography

##### Red Sand Dunes of Theri Kaadu

- 
- Theri Kaadu is a little-known desert of striking red sand dunes formed by *iron-rich soil*.
- 
- Located in** - Thoothukudi district, Tamil Nadu.
- 
- Unlike Rajasthan's golden sands, these dunes glow rust-red under the sun.
- 
- The landscape, dotted with palm trees and small villages, creates a rare coastal-desert contrast.

## Social Issues

### UN Report on Women

- **Key findings**
  - Women hold only 64% of men's legal rights.
  - No country has achieved full legal equality for women and girls.
  - 54% of nations lack consent-based rape laws.
  - 3 in 4 countries still allow child marriage.
  - 44% of countries lack equal pay laws.
- **Highlight** - The rising digital violence and sexual violence in conflicts, which increased 87% in two years.
- **Urgent action** - At 70th Commission on the Status of Women (CSW70), UN Women is urging decisive measures under the theme '*Rights. Justice. Action. For ALL Women and Girls.*'

### Women Empowerment - Gender Empowerment Casebook

- **Legal Aid** - *NyayaSakhi (SWATI, Maharashtra)* - AI-supported legal assistant for domestic violence survivors, offering guidance on rights, remedies, and case timelines.
- **STEM Promotion** - *AtenIA (Peru)* - "Phygital" mentoring model (books + conversational AI) that redirects biased prompts to highlight women's leadership in STEM; intention to pursue STEM rose from 9% to 76%.
- **Digital Literacy** - *YASHODA AI* - Empowers rural and semi-urban women to spot AI-driven harms such as deepfakes and financial scams.
- **Agricultural Advisory & Credit** - *MetsaQ (Odisha)* - Voice-based advisories via small language models, partnered with SHGs; 42% women users, with 34% farmers accessing formal credit.

### Pad Yatras

- **Held under** - Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP).
- **Organized at** - 30+ locations across India with thousands of participants.
- **Objective** - To raise awareness about affordable, quality generic medicines.
- **Awareness** - Medicines at Jan Aushadhi Kendras cost 50-80% less than branded alternatives, reducing healthcare expenses without compromising quality.

## Global Burden of Disease data (1990-2023)

- **India's burden (2023)**

- **Type 2 diabetes** - ~21 million disability-adjusted life years (DALYs), 5.8 lakh deaths.

- **High systolic BP** - ~3.8 crore DALYs, 15.7 lakh deaths.

- **Rising risks** - High BMI (2.7-2.9% annually), LDL cholesterol, MASLD.

- **Regional trends -**

- India overtook China in DALYs for diabetes, topping the list.

- For other risk factors, India ranks second but is closing the gap with China.

- Together, both countries represent the heaviest global burden.

## **Polity & Governance**

### Appointment of Lieutenant Governor (LG)

*President appointed Taranjit Singh Sandhu as the new Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, succeeding Vinai Kumar Saxena.*

- **Constitutional Basis**

- **Articles 239-241** - Part VIII governs Union Territories (UTs).

- **Article 239** - Every UT is administered by the President of India through an Administrator appointed by him, with a designation specified by the President.

- **Appointment Process**

- **Article 239AA** - Specifically mandates that Delhi's Administrator shall be designated as the LG.

- **Article 74** - President acts on the aid & advice of the Council of Ministers, Central Government recommends LG.

- **Tenure & Removal**

- Holds office "during the pleasure of the President."

- No fixed term or constitutional grounds for removal.

- Central Government can advise the President to transfer, remove, or seek resignation of an LG at any time.

## **Agriculture**

## Artificial Intelligence in Agriculture (Casebook)

- **Yield Prediction** - *MapMyCrop* utilizes multi-sensor satellite imagery to forecast sucrose peaks in sugarcane, resulting in a 57% improvement in yield.

- **Soil Chemistry** - *Chemistry-Aware Crop Yield Prediction* employs physics-guided machine learning with satellite data to identify toxicities and nutrient imbalances, facilitating a 28% reduction in nitrogen use while increasing yields.

- **Advisory Systems** - *MahaVISTAAR (Maharashtra) and FarmAdvice (Africa)* utilize natural language processing and voice-first interfaces to provide expert-reviewed guidance in local dialects regarding pest outbreaks and weather anomalies.

## Science

### Linking Patients' Digital Health Records (ABHA-IDs)

National Medical Commission (NMC) has directed medical colleges to link all patients' ABHA) IDs.

- **Objectives** -

- To ensure objective verification by eliminating fake patients.

- To increase transparency in medical college evaluations.

- To strengthen the digital health ecosystem with secure, paperless records.

- **Additional directives** -

- Submit Health Facility Registry (HFR) IDs of hospitals.

- Confirm integration of hospital software with the ABDM platform and PM-JAY portal.

- **Notes**

- **ABHA-ID** - A unique 14-digit number under the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM) that enables digital health record linkage for Indian patients.

- HFR serves as a centralized repository of public and private healthcare facilities in India.
