- **Released by -** Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY).
- **Compliance with -** The directions of the Madras High Court (Writ Petition).
- Legal status -
- Rule 3(2)(b) of the Information Technology (Intermediary Guidelines and Digital Media Ethics Code) Rules, 2021.
 - The Indecent Representation of Women (Prohibition) Act, 1986.
 - Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023.
- **Aim** To strengthen mechanisms for the removal and prevention of Non-Consensual Intimate Imagery (NCII) content on online platforms.

Environment

Ricin

- **Ricin** It is a highly toxic poison derived from castor beans plant, *Ricinus communis* after the oil has been extracted.
- Ricin can be in the form of a *powder*, a mist, or a pellet.
- It can also be dissolved in water or weak acid.
- It is stable under normal conditions.
- However, it will not work if temperatures are <u>over 80 degrees centigrade (176 degrees Fahrenheit).</u>
- No known antidote If ingested, inhaled or injected.

- It is a National Cybersecurity Exercise titled <u>"Cyber Bharat Setu: Bridging States, Securing Bharat."</u>
- **Organised by -** Directorate of Information Technology (DIT), Tripura, with Indian Computer Emergency Response Team (CERT-In), MeitY.
- **Aim** To build a cyber resilient Bharat through capacity building, innovation, and proactive defence strategies.

Places in News

Mount Kilimanjaro

A new study highlights the significant impact of human activities on its biodiversity, surpassing climate change effects.

- It is an *Africa's highest peak, a dormant volcano in Tanzania*, known for its diverse ecosystems and iconic glaciers.
- Human Impacts
 - **Population expansion -** Increasing human population on lower slopes.
 - Land use change Conversion of natural savannahs into farms and towns.
 - **Result -** Overwhelming 75% loss of native plant species since 1911.

Miscellaneous

Ande Sri

- Original name Ande Yellanna, was renowned poet and lyricist.
- Born in 1961, in Siddipet district, Telangana.
- Author of The iconic Telangana State song "Java Javahe Telangana,".
- This song which became the rallying cry of millions during the movement for separate statehood and has been adopted as the *official State Anthem*.
- "Maayamaipothunnadamma Manishanavadu, song in Erra Samudram film, was included in textbooks by Andhra Pradesh University's syllabus committee in 2009.
- Awards Nandi Award for Best Lyricist in 2006 for his work on the film Ganga.
- Kakatiya University conferred an honorary doctorate for his contribution to Telangana movement.

Public Service Broadcasting Day

- Observed annually on 12th November.
- Started in 2000, by Ministry for Information and Broadcasting.
- **Aim** To mark the historic address of father of the nation and freedom fighter Mahatma Gandhi through the radio.
