History, Art and Culture

Hindi Diwas or National Hindi Day

- **Celebrated annually on** - 14th September
- **Decided to celebrate by** - 1st Indian PM Jawaharlal Nehru.
- **Commemorates to** - The adaptation of Hindi (written in Devanagari script) as the official language by the Constituent Assembly on September 14, 1949.
- **Aim** - To promote Hindi language across the world.

World Hindi Day

- **Celebrated annually on** - 10th January.
- **1st celebrated in** - 2006, by former PM Dr Manmohan Singh.
- **Commemorate to** - The anniversary of the 1st World Hindi Conference held in Nagpur of January 10, 1975.
- **Theme 2025** - Global Voice of Unity and Cultural Pride.
- **Aim** - To promote Hindi language across the world.

Hindi

- It is the official language of India and 5th most spoken language among the total languages spoken in the world.
- **Named from** - the Persian word Hind, meaning 'land of the Indus River'.
- Turkish invaders (early 11th century) named the language of the region Hindi, 'language of the land of the Indus River'.
- **Spoken in another countries** - Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh, USA, UK, Germany, New Zealand, United Arab Emirates, Uganda, Guyana, Suriname, Trinidad, Mauritius, South Africa, Fiji, Suriname, Guyana, Trinidad & Tobago.
- **Important contributions by** - Kaka Kalelkar, Maithili Sharan Gupta, Hazari Prasad Dwivedi and Seth Govindadas etc.

International Relations and Issues

Nepal's 1st Woman Prime Minister (PM)

- **1st woman PM** - Former Chief Justice Sushila Karki for interim period.
- **Background** - "Gen Z" protests that led to PM K.P. Sharma Oli's resignation.

Environment

"Blue Tides-Two Shores One Vision" Conclave

- **Organised by** - State's Fisheries, Union government & European Union (EU).
- **Aim** - To build EU-Kerala partnership in ocean-based economy.
- **Significance** - To foster sustainable development through marine logistics, marine fisheries, aquaculture, coastal tourism, renewable marine energy, and green technologies.
- To promote skill development, academic collaboration, labour mobility, policy innovation, joint research & development and start-up innovation.

Blue economy

- It is an *economic model* that involves the sustainable use of coastal and marine resources to drive economic growth and livelihoods, while prioritising the health of oceans.
- **Coined in** - 1994, by Belgian economist Gunter Pauli.
- **Attention** - After the United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development (UNCSD) in 2012, also known as Rio+20, held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.
- **United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs)** - 17 Life below water.
- **Components**
 - Sustainable fisheries & aquaculture,
 - Maritime transport,
 - Marine renewable energy,
 - Coastal tourism,
 - Marine biotechnology & blue carbon.

Security

Zapad 2025

A multilateral military exercise creates regional tension near border areas.

- **"Zapad"** - It means "west" in the Russian language.
- **1st occurred in** - 1999, after post-Soviet Union dissolution.
- **Taken place** - Every 4 years since 2009.
- **Joint military exercise between** - *Russian and Belarusian*.
- **Take place in** - Belarus, which borders several EU and NATO members such as *Poland, Latvia and Lithuania and Ukraine*.
- **Aim** - To enhance military cooperation and combat readiness in multinational Warfield environment.
- **Last held in** - 2021, prior to Russia's full-scale invasion of Ukraine.
- *Indian Armed Forces* participated in this drill.

Science

World's 1st AI-Minister

Albania's PM Edi Rama appointed an AI-generated 'minister' to his cabinet.

- **AI-generated 'minister' name** - "Diella" means 'sun' in Albanian language.
- **Aim** - To ensure public tenders are "100% free of corruption."

Diella

- **1st launched in** - January 2025, as an AI-powered virtual assistant on the e-Albania platform, helping
- **Dressed in** - Traditional Albanian attire.
- **Assistance to** - Citizens and businesses in obtaining state documents through voice commands, and issuing documents with electronic stamps, thereby reducing bureaucratic delays.

World Boxing Championships 2025

Jasmine Lamboria and Minakshi Hooda are 2 Indian women to win a gold medal at the World Boxing Championships 2025.

- It is the 1st Elite-level global championships.
- **Conducted by** - World boxing.
- **Participants** - Over 60 countries.
