Geography

Warming Nights & Its Threat

- **Rising Night Heat** - Experts warn that warmer nights limit the body's ability to recover from daytime heat.
- **Health Risks** - Persistent warm nights increase chances of *heat exhaustion, cardiovascular stress, and sleep disruption*.
- **Caused by** - Urbanisation, loss of green spaces, and the urban heat island effect worsen night-time temperatures.
- **Vulnerable Groups** - Poor and densely populated communities face higher risks due to inadequate housing and cooling options.
- **Key Facts**
 - India's average temperature rose *0.7°C (1901-2018)*.
 - Night-time temperatures rising faster than daytime.
 - High humidity reduces cooling efficiency through sweating.
 - Heat exposure linked to higher mortality, heart and respiratory illnesses, and reduced productivity.
- **Adaptation Measures** - Cool roofs, better urban planning, more tree cover, reflective materials, improved ventilation, and early warning systems.

Global Recognition for Agriculture

- **Held in** - FAO Headquarters in Rome.
- **Award** - Agricola Medal for 2026, by the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations.
- **Objective** - To recognize PM's exceptional leadership to address food security, sustainable agriculture and rural development in India and at the global level.

68th APO Governing Body Meeting

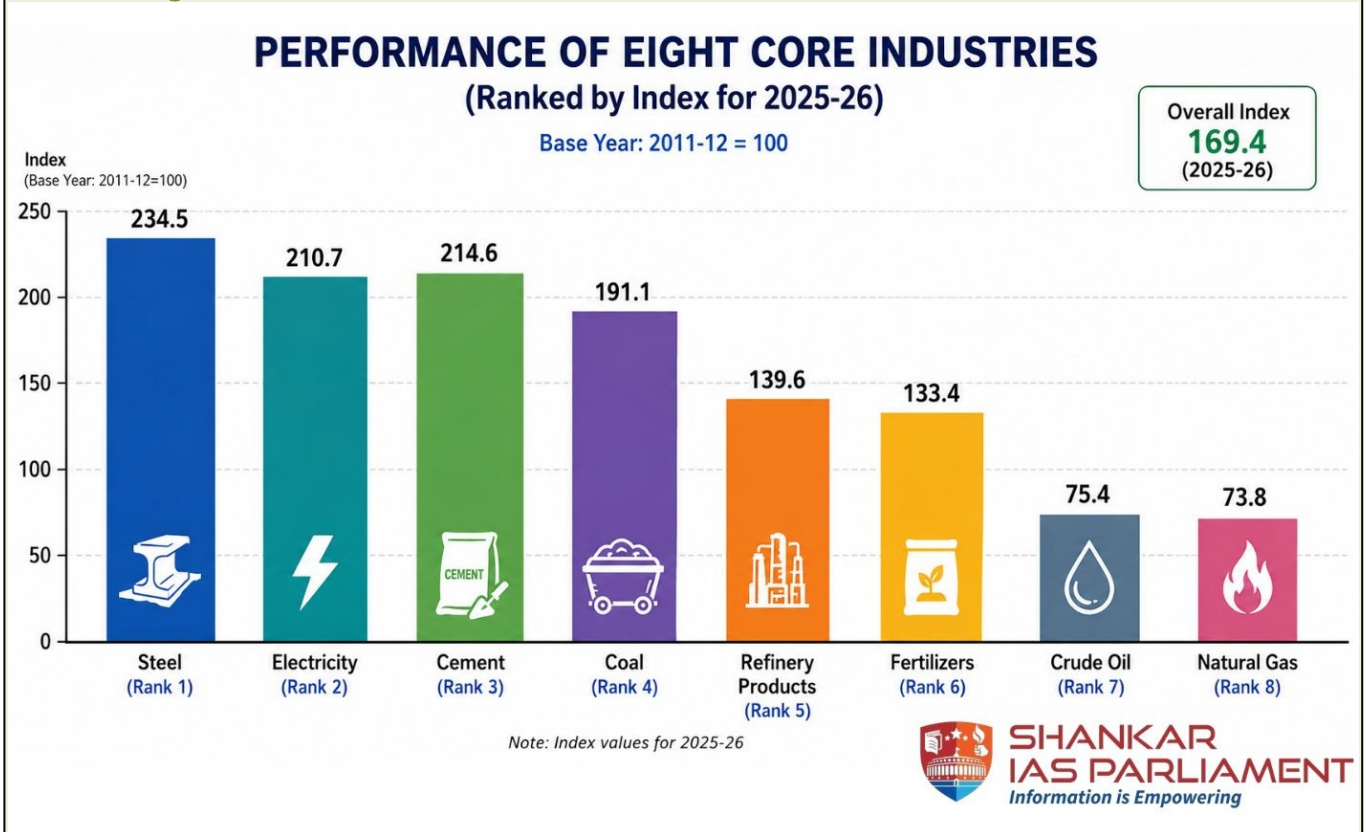
- **Hosted by** - India in New Delhi from 20-22 May 2026.

 - **Growth** - Crossed 9 crore enrolments; 1.35 crore new subscribers added in FY 2025-26; AUM exceeded Rs.54,000 crore.
 - **Women Participation** - Reached a *record 55.14% in FY 2025-26.*
 - **Youth Enrolment** - Significant rise among 18-25 age group, showing growing awareness of retirement planning.
- **Focus on** - Subscriber persistency, financial literacy, outreach in urban informal sector, and pension awareness.

Launch of Sanghmitra (Yard 3039)

- It is a Next Generation Offshore Patrol Vessel (NGOPV).
- **Launched at** - GRSE, Kolkata.
- **Part of** - 11 NGOPVs being built indigenously at Goa Shipyard Ltd (GSL) and GRSE.
- **Name from** - India's heritage, 'Sanghmitra', after the daughter of *King Ashoka.*
- **Crest design** - It depicts the constellation of Ursa Major and a red and white coloured lighthouse.
- **Designed for** - Surveillance, defence, search & rescue, offshore asset protection, HADR, and anti-piracy missions.
- **Significance** - Aligned with *Aatmanirbhar Bharat* and *Make in India* initiative.

Multilateral Exercise PRAGATI 2026

- **PRAGATI** - *Partnership of Regional Armies for Growth and Transformation in the Indian Ocean Region*.
- **Commenced at** - Umroi Military Station, Meghalaya.
- **Participants** - Bhutan, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Philippines, Seychelles, Sri Lanka, and Vietnam.
- **Focus on** - Counter-terrorism operations in semi-mountainous and jungle terrain.
- **Objectives** - To enhance joint coordination, share expertise, strengthen defence ties through training and cultural exchange.
 - To establish common intelligence-sharing practices.

- **Observed annually on** - 20th May.

- **Coordinated by** - International Bureau of Weights and Measures (BIPM) and the International Organization of Legal Metrology (OIML).

- **Objective** - To mark the 151st anniversary of the historic Metre Convention signed in Paris on 20th May 1875.
- **Significance** - This celebration reaffirmed the commitment towards building a modern, efficient and trusted measurement system in the country.
