#### History, Art and Culture

##### Shaheed Diwas Tribute 23<sup>rd</sup> March

PM Modi paid solemn tribute to iconic freedom fighters Bhagat Singh, Rajguru, and Sukhdev on Shaheed Diwas, honoring their supreme sacrifice for India.

• In 1931, these three young icons were executed by the colonial government for their roles in the *Lahore Conspiracy Case and the 1929 Central Legislative Assembly bombing*.

• **Historic Significance** - Their sacrifice marked a pivotal shift in the Indian independence movement, moving away from traditional petitioning, toward a more assertive demand for *Purna Swaraj* (Complete Independence).

• **Core Ideals**

• **Inquilab Zindabad**- A slogan popularized by Bhagat Singh that became the heartbeat of the youth movement.

• **Fearless Resistance** - Choosing the gallows over compromise to ignite a fire in the hearts of fellow citizens.

• **Social Justice** - Bhagat Singh's writings emphasized a vision for an India free from both foreign rule and internal exploitation.

• **Modern Remembrance** - Across the nation, tributes involve floral offerings, seminars on revolutionary history, and silent prayers to these "*Sons of Bharat Mata*," ensuring their commitment to the nation remains etched in collective memory.

## **Birth Anniversary of Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia**

PM Modi paid solemn tributes to the legendary socialist thinker, **Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia**, on his birth anniversary on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, honoring his enduring legacy in Indian politics.

**Role in the Freedom Movement** - Dr. Lohia was a pivotal figure in the **Quit India Movement (1942)**. Alongside other socialist leaders, he operated underground radio stations.

### **Core Philosophies**

**'Sapta Kranti' theory:** A comprehensive framework for global and domestic transformation.

He believed that political independence was only the beginning and that true freedom required the abolition of seven specific types of injustice:

- **Gender Equality** - Ending the inequality between men and women.
- **Against Racial Inequality** - Abolition of inequalities based on skin color or race.
- **Caste Abolition** - Eradication of the caste system and the privileges associated with "high birth."
- **End of Colonialism** - Freedom from foreign rule and the liberation of all colonized people.
- **Economic Equality** - Eliminating vast disparities in wealth and striving for planned production.
- **Right to Privacy** - Protecting the individual against unjust interference from the state or collective.
- **Non-violence** - The rejection of weapons and the promotion of *Satyagraha* (civil resistance) as a tool for change.

## **Polity & Governance**

### **Digital Lending for Frontline Heroes**

The portal specifically targets *Defence personnel, Paramilitary forces, and Government employees*.

- It allows them to secure housing finance directly from their remote postings or administrative units without physical bank visits.
- **Unified Digital Marketplace** - Gruh Sugam acts as a transparent hub where users can discover and compare various loan products.
- **Seamless Integration** - Real-time connectivity between the NHB, lenders, and government units.
- **Simplified Application** - Employees register with minimal data to receive competitive institutional offers.
- **Efficiency and Support** - The platform features enhanced processing speeds, grievance redressal, and an *online chat facility* for instant query resolution.
- **Financial Inclusion Impact** - By digitizing the "last mile," the portal accelerates affordable home ownership and ensures financial services reach even the most geographically isolated personnel.
- **Strengthening National Housing** - This initiative bolsters the mission of sustainable housing finance while promoting transparency and consumer protection across the lending ecosystem.

## **Election Commission of India Allots Digital Time Vouchers**

ECI has issued digital time vouchers to recognized National and State political parties for the 2026 Assembly Elections in Assam, Kerala, Puducherry, Tamil Nadu & West Bengal.

- **Initiative under** - The *Representation of the People Act, 1951*, ensures equitable access to public airwaves.
- **Broadcast Scheduling** - Parties can utilize Doordarshan and All India Radio (AIR) from the date candidate lists are finalized until 48 hours before polling.
- Specific slots are determined via a transparent draw of lots involving party representatives and state election officials.
- **Time Allocation Formula** - Each party receives a base of **45 minutes** on regional networks. Supplemental time is granted based on the party's performance in previous state assembly elections.
- **Content Guidelines** - Parties must submit transcripts and recordings in advance, ensuring they meet Prasar Bharati's technical standards. Recording facilities are available at Doordarshan and AIR Kendras.
- **Panel Discussions** - Beyond solo broadcasts, Prasar Bharati will host up to two moderated panel discussions or debates, allowing each eligible party to nominate one representative to participate.

## **Economy**

### **Indian health insurance experiencing Growth**

Indian health insurance sector is experiencing a **9% growth surge**, with premiums surpassing **₹1.2 lakh crore** in 2024-25, driven by rising medical awareness and expanded coverage.

- **Robust Market Momentum** - The sector's growth reflects a higher demand for financial protection. Factors like an aging population and enhanced policy features have contributed to this record premium volume.
- **Accelerated Cashless Processing** - To improve patient care, *Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI)* has mandated strict timelines: **one hour** for cashless pre-authorization and three hours for final discharge authorization.
- *The IRDAI is India's statutory body that regulates and promotes the insurance industry. It protects policyholders' interests while ensuring the sector's financial viability through strict licensing, pricing, and claims-processing standards.*
- **Claims paid ratio** - Reached a high of **87.50%** in 2024-25, showing a steady recovery and improvement in operational efficiency compared to previous years.
- **Efficient Grievance Redressal** - According to the Bima Bharosa portal, the industry successfully resolved **93%** of the 1.37 lakh reported grievances within the same financial year.
- **Understanding Claim Disallowance** - Repudiations often stem from specific policy limits, such as room rent capping, co-payments, and non-medical expenses, rather than systemic failures.
- **Regulatory Oversight** - IRDAI's 2024 regulations ensure that products remain fairly priced and value-driven, utilizing actuary reviews and customer feedback to maintain transparency.

## **Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) and KRAFTON Partner to Bolster India's Digital Economy**

The **DPIIT** has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with **KRAFTON India Private Limited** to strengthen the startup ecosystem in digital entertainment and AI.

- **Collaboration** - Targets product startups in *online gaming, esports, and interactive media*, helping them develop scalable, industry-relevant solutions through structured engagement.
- **Mentorship** - Startups will gain access to expert mentorship and knowledge exchange platforms, providing critical insights into global best practices and emerging technology trends.
- **Proof-of-Concept (PoC)** - Facilitated by Partners development and market access, ensuring innovators can integrate effectively into the broader industrial ecosystem.
- **Innovation Challenges** - Both entities will organize the Bharat Startup Grand Challenge, featuring hackathons and masterclasses in game design, animation, and immersive technologies.
- **Global Connectivity** - Selected startups may explore pilot collaborations, benefiting from exposure to global standards and fostering a more competitive creative economy.
- **Ecosystem Expansion** - By aligning with the Startup India initiative, this MoU enhances outreach and ensures sustainable growth for entrepreneurs in high-tech domains.

## **India Launches Seventh Tranche of Critical Mineral Auctions**

Ministry of Mines launched the 7th Tranche of auctions for 19 critical mineral blocks on March 23, 2026, to secure India's green energy future.

- **Resource Security** - Minerals like Lithium and Rare Earth Elements are vital for high-tech industries.
- Geographical scarcity makes domestic auctioning essential for resilient national supply chains.
- **Legal Framework** - The 2023 amendment to the *Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act (MMDR Act)* enables the Centre to auction 24 specific strategic minerals.
- **Revenue for State Governments** - While the Central Government conducts the bidding for Mining Leases, all generated revenue flows directly to the respective State Governments.
- **Sustained Auction Momentum** - Building on six successful rounds, the Ministry has already auctioned **46 blocks**, demonstrating high industry confidence in India's mineral sector.
- **Scope of the Seventh Tranche** - This round offers 19 new blocks across multiple states, providing essential raw materials for fertilizers, defence, and clean energy technologies.
- **2026 Regulatory Reforms** - New *Mineral (Auction) Amendment Rules introduce Insurance Surety Bonds*, offering bidders flexible alternatives to traditional bank guarantees for faster project operationalization.

## **Security**

### • **India-Seychelles Landmark Tri-Services Exercise**

INS Trikand recently concluded the first-ever tri-services edition of **Exercise Lamitiye 2026** in Seychelles, marking the Indian Navy's maiden participation in this historically bilateral engagement.

- **Strengthening Strategic Ties** - Meaning "friendship" in Creole, Lamitiye reflects the deep-rooted partnership between India and the *Seychelles Defence Forces (SDF)*, enhancing regional maritime cooperation.
- **Specialized Tactical Training** - The harbor phase focused on **VBSS (Visit, Board, Search, and Seizure)** drills, fostering seamless coordination between Indian Marine Commandos and SDF Special Forces.
- **Joint Sea Operations** - During the sea phase, INS Trikand and **SCGS Le Vigilant** executed complex boarding operations and coordinated troop landings on Praslin Island.
- **Critical Resource Support** - Beyond combat drills, India handed over essential stores and critical spares to the Seychelles Government, reinforcing its role as a reliable regional partner.
- **Vision of MAHASAGAR** - This mission aligns with India's MAHASAGAR initiative, positioning the Indian Navy as the "Preferred Security Partner" and "First Responder" in the Indian Ocean.

## Science

### Kavach

Indian Railway recently reviewed **Kavach**, India's indigenous *Automatic Train Protection system*, focusing on rapid deployment and high-tech integration to bolster rail safety.

- **Technological Innovation** - The system now features a *Universal Braking Algorithm (UBA)* to standardize performance across manufacturers, alongside AI-driven design automation and enhanced interlocking software for locomotive stability.
- **Real-Time Monitoring** - Railways is developing *SURAKSHA*, a centralized platform for operational management.
- This system enables predictive maintenance and real-time oversight of all Kavach installations nationwide.
- **Implementation Milestones** - Kavach is active on **3,103 route km**, with version 4.0 recently commissioned on the 190 km Prayagraj-Kanpur section of the critical Delhi-Howrah corridor.
- **Infrastructure Progress** - *Work spans 24,427 km, supported by 8,921 km of Optical Fiber Cable, 1,183 telecom towers, and data centers at 767 stations.*
- **Locomotive Integration** - Currently, **4,277 locomotives** are equipped with Kavach, with installations underway for an additional 8,979 engines to ensure comprehensive fleet coverage.
- **Ambitious Expansion Goals** - The network aims to add **9,000 km** over the next two years, eventually scaling to a massive deployment rate of **10,000 km annually**.
