# Export Preparedness Index (EPI)

- It aims to identify challenges and opportunities, enhance the effectiveness of government policies and encourage a facilitative regulatory framework for export.
- The index ranked states on four key pillars: Policy, Business Ecosystem, Export Ecosystem, Export Performance.
- The index also took into consideration 11 sub-pillars such as export promotion policy; institutional framework; business environment; infrastructure; transport connectivity; access to finance; export infrastructure; trade support; R&D infrastructure; export diversification; and growth orientation.

## **Water Treaties and Agreements of India**

• A Treaty has been signed with Nepal in the year 1996, viz. Mahakali Treaty concerning

Integrated Development of the Mahakali River (known as river 'Sarda' in India).

- In addition, Kosi Agreement, 1954 (amended in December 1966) and Gandak Agreement, 1959 (amended in April 1964) were signed with Nepal for the construction of the Kosi Project and Gandak Project respectively.
- Both of these projects are irrigation projects.



- It starts from the Harike Barrage, below the confluence of the Satluj and Beas rivers in the Indian state of Punjab, and terminates in irrigation facilities in the Thar Desert in the northwest of Rajasthan.
- It passes through the states of Punjab, Rajasthan, and Haryana.

## PM SVANidhi Scheme

• The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) has launched Pradhan Mantri Street Vendor's Atma Nirbhar Nidhi (PM SVANidhi), for providing affordable loans to street vendors.

- The scheme would benefit vendors, hawkers, thelewale, and people involved in goods and services related to textiles, apparel, artisan products, barbershops, laundry services, etc.
- It is for the first time that Microfinance Institutions, Non-Banking Financial Companies, Self Help Groups have been allowed in a scheme for the urban poor due to their ground-level presence and proximity to the urban poor including the street vendors.

- NIPUN Bharat will be implemented by the Department of School Education and Literacy.
- A five-tier implementation mechanism will be set up at the National- State- District- Block-School level in all States and UTs, under the aegis of the centrally sponsored scheme of Samagra Shiksha.
