Seabed 2030 Project :

• The aim is correctly stated as mapping the entire ocean floor by 2030. (*Statement 2 is correct*).

• The initiative does not focus on creating new war museums but rather promotes existing historical military sites for tourism. (*Statement 2 is not correct*).

- This initiative is part of a broader mission to promote traditional medicinal plants and support national wellness goals, with the Ministry aiming to make India a developed nation by its 100th Independence Day in 2047.

Nematodes

- Nematodes are cylindrical worms (commonly called as eelworms or threadworms) that can be parasitic in both plants and animals. (*Statement 1 is correct*).
- Nematodes are **found in both terrestrial and aquatic habitats.** They occur as parasites in animals and plants or as free-living forms in soil, fresh water, marine environments, and even such unusual places as vinegar, beer malts, and water-filled cracks deep within Earth's crust. (*Statement 2 is not correct*).
- Nematodes damage plant roots, leading to stunted growth, reduced yields, and increased susceptibility to diseases. (*Statement 3 is correct*)..

- It also involves the support of state governments, urban local bodies, voluntary organizations, and community-based organizations to work together for the welfare of marginalized individuals. (*Statement 2 is correct*).
