# Search And Rescue Aid Tool (SARAT):

Information is Empowering

- SARAT was developed by The <u>Indian National Centre for Ocean</u>
  <u>Information Services</u>, (not by National Disaster Response Force NDRF).
  (Option (a) is not correct).
- It is designed to aid in search and rescue operations in the seas by predicting the drift trajectories of missing vessels or individuals, improving the efficiency of rescue missions.
- It is anchored to the Last Known Position (LKP) of the object rather than the minimum longitude in the search area.
- SARAT functions under the Ministry of Earth Sciences.
- SARAT uses drift prediction models based on ocean currents and wind patterns for tracking missing vessels.

### **Aatmanirbharta in Pulses:**

- The <u>Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare</u> is the nodal ministry overseeing the initiative of Aatmanirbharta in Pulses to boost domestic pulse production. (Statement 1 is correct).
- It focuses on achieving <u>self-sufficiency in the production of Tur,</u> <u>Urad, and Masoor</u>. (Statement 2 is correct).
- Under this mission, National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India (NAFED) and National Cooperative Consumers' Federation of India (NCCF) will procure Tur, Urad, and Masoor from farmers who register and enter into agreements with them.
- The <u>mission aims to reduce import dependency by boosting</u> <u>domestic production of pulses</u>. (not to increase the export of Indian pulses to global markets). (Statement 3 is not correct).

# **Dibru-Saikhowa National Park:**

- Dibru-Saikhowa National Park is a national park and biosphere reserve located in Assam, India, specifically in the districts of Dibrugarh and Tinsukia. *(Statement 1 is correct).*
- It mainly consists of moist mixed semi-evergreen forests, moist mixed deciduous forests, canebrakes, and grasslands. It is also the largest salix swamp forest in north-eastern India. (Statement 2 is correct).
- The park was originally created to help conserve the habitat of the rare white-winged wood duck, whereby it is also home to other rare creatures such as water buffalo, black-breasted parrotbill, tiger and capped langur. (Statement 3 is correct).
- The park is situated around 12 km north of Tinsukia town and is bounded by the *Brahmaputra and Lohit rivers in the north and the Dibru River in the south*. (Statement 4 is not correct).
