 - **East - Uganda, Rwanda, Burundi, and Tanzania.**
 - **Southeast - Zambia Angola.**
- **Ethiopia does not share the border** with the Democratic Republic of Congo. **Option (c) is correct.**

- Central Board of Film Certification (CBFC) is **a statutory body under Ministry of Information and Broadcasting,** regulating the public exhibition of films under the provisions of the Cinematograph Act 1952. **Statement 1 and 2 are correct.**
- **Films can be publicly exhibited in India only after they have been certified by the Central Board of Film Certification.** **Statement 3 is correct.**
- The Certification process is in accordance with The Cinematograph Act, 1952, The Cinematograph (certification) Rules, 1983, and the guidelines issued by the Central government.

- It detects and transmits information about human and wildlife activities in remote areas in under 30 seconds.
- It autonomously detects target objects, and **transmits real-time alerts that can trigger**
 - **Rapid-response to entry by poachers or illegal loggers.**
 - **Wildlife entering agricultural or pastoral lands.**
 - **Status of endangered or exotic invasive species.** **Statement 2 is correct.**
- Its application is used in multiple cases such as, Human-wildlife conflict, Park intrusion monitoring, Wildlife monitoring, Illegal logging, Mine security, Border security.
- It **does not includes the prediction of earthquakes and landslides in the fragile areas.** **Statement 3 is not correct.**
