- It aims to enhance livelihood opportunities, transfer appropriate technology, and promote

sustainable fisheries.

- It plays a key role in ensuring food security, marine resource management, and regional cooperation.

- The phrase was coined by poet Banke Dayal to inspire farmers to resist British policies.
- The movement influenced later revolutionary actions, including the Ghadar Movement and Bhagat Singh’s activism.
