1) Consider the following statements regarding the recent RBI measure on NBFC lending

- 1. RBI has reduced the risk weight on all bank loans given to NBFCs by 25% points.
- 2. The reduction in risk weight will be uniform across all NBFCs regardless of their credit rating.
- 3. The move is expected to enhance liquidity in the NBFC sector, leading to increased lending to the retail segment.

Answer: b

Non-Banking Financial Companies (NBFCs)

- RBI has reduced the risk weight on all bank loans given to NBFCs by 25 percentage points.
- The RBI has reduced the risk weights applied to bank loans given to NBFCs by **25% points**, makes easier for banks to lend to NBFCs.
- This move aims to enhance liquidity in the sector.
- The reduction in risk weight *depends on the credit rating* of each NBFC.
- Higher-rated NBFCs will benefit more from this relaxation, meaning the measure is not applied uniformly to all NBFCs.

- 2) Consider the following statements:
 - 1. Influenza is a contagious viral infection classified into four types (A, B, C, and D), but only A, B, and C affect humans.
 - 2. VaxiFlu-4 is a quadrivalent inactivated vaccine and India's first flu vaccine for new influenza strains designed to protect against the strains of influenza A and B.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

Answer : c

Influenza & VaxiFlu-4

- Influenza is a highly contagious viral infection that primarily affects the respiratory system.
- It is classified into four types A, B, C, and D.
- However, only Influenza A, B, and C affect humans, while Influenza D mainly affects cattle.
- VaxiFlu-4 is a Quadrivalent Inactivated Influenza Virus Vaccine made as per WHO-recommended composition, designed to protect against two Influenza A and two Influenza B virus strains.
- VaxiFlu-4, developed by Zydus Lifesciences, is a quadrivalent (four-strain) inactivated influenza vaccine.

3) Under which of the following conditions can the Lokpal proceed investigation against a sitting High Court judge?

Lokpal's order on complaint against High Court judge

- Sitting High Court judges are protected under various legal provisions that prevent direct investigation by Lokpal.
- Presidential sanction, along with consultation with the Chief Justice of India, is mandatory before proceeding with corruption cases against sitting judges.

Cholanaikkan Tribes

- The Cholanaikkans do not speak a modern Dravidian language.
- Their language is isolated and not directly linked to any modern Dravidian languages.
- They are the *only cave dwelling community* in India.
- The Cholanaikkans are classified as a Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Group (PVTG) in India due to their small population, traditional lifestyle, and limited interaction with outsiders.

Delimitation Exercise

• As per Article 82 of the Constitution, delimitation is conducted after every Census to readjust the allocation of Lok Sabha seats among states.

SHANKAR

- However, due to *constitutional amendments (42nd and 84th)*, the number of seats has been frozen until 2026.
- Once the Delimitation Commission's orders are published, they <u>cannot be</u> <u>challenged in court</u>.
- As per **Article 329A** and the Delimitation Commission Act, 1952, these orders are final and binding.
