Cantor's Giant Softshell Turtle

- Cantor's Giant Softshell Turtle is <u>native to the rivers of south and</u> <u>south-east Asia</u>.
- It can be found on the banks of the Chandragiri River in Kerala, southern India.

- **Habitat** Inhabits inland, slow-moving freshwater rivers, lakes, streams, and estuaries across Southeast Asia.
- **Conservation Status** Critically Endangered due to habitat destruction and overharvesting.
- **Notable Characteristics** Spends most of its life buried and motionless, surfacing only twice a day to breathe and capture prey.

- Their larvae feed on decaying wood and plant matter, playing an essential role in maintaining forest ecosystem balance.

- Samaveshi Aajeevika Yojana is implemented under DAY-NRLM.

- It follows the <u>Graduation Approach</u>, which includes skill training, financial services, and mentorship to help poor households become self-reliant.

- The scheme aligns with India's women-led development vision by promoting entrepreneurship and self-sufficiency among rural women.

Reciprocal tariffs

- It is to ensure fair trade by imposing import duties equal to the tariffs that other nations impose on a country's exports.
- This discourages trade imbalances and tariff discrimination.
- India had a USD 50 billion trade surplus with the U.S. in 2023, meaning India exported much more to the U.S. than it imported.
- To reduce its trade deficit, the U.S. may impose higher tariffs on key Indian exports, such as pharmaceutical.
