### Marbled Cat

- **Nocturnal Behavior** – The Marbled Cat (*Pardofelis marmorata*) is primarily active at night, making it a nocturnal species.
- **Habitat & Distribution** – It is a small wild cat native to the eastern Himalayas and Southeast Asia, found in countries like India, Nepal, Bhutan, Myanmar, Thailand and Malaysia.
- **IUCN Status** – The Marbled Cat is classified as "Near Threatened (NT)" on the IUCN Red List due to habitat loss and poaching.

### Doubtful Voters

- Doubtful Voters (D Voters) are those **whose citizenship status is in question, meaning their eligibility to vote is uncertain.**
- They are identified during the electoral roll revision process by election officials if there are doubts about their citizenship.
- Their cases are either pending with the Foreigners Tribunals or they have already been declared as foreigners by the tribunal.
- Until their citizenship status is resolved, they are not allowed to vote in elections.

- While it is not life-threatening, it can lead to psychological and social impacts due to visible skin changes.

- **Cosmetics & Household Uses** - It is an ingredient in hair dyes, toothpaste, and wound disinfectants.
