India Cotton sector

- SHANKAR
- India is the <u>second-largest producer</u> of cotton after China.
- The Cotton Corporation of India operates under the **Ministry of Textiles**.
- Maharashtra is the largest cotton-producing state in India.

Answer: c

Tiger Conservation

- NTCA was established in 2005 under the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972.
- The All India Tiger Estimation is conducted *every 4 years*.
- India holds about 70% of the global tiger population. Collision-less Shock Waves

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- 3) Which of the following is a key application of studying collision-less shock waves?
 - a. Earthquake prediction
 - b. Space weather forecasting
 - c. Deep-sea exploration
 - d. Improving wireless communication

Answer: b

Collision-less shock waves

- Collision-less shock waves occur in space near pulsars, magnetars and black holes.
- It occurs in low-density plasmas where particles rarely collide.
- It helps scientists understand how high-energy cosmic rays are accelerated.
- NASA satellites have detected electrons accelerating up to 86% of light speed due to these shock waves.

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- 4) Which international organizations monitor the minimum dietary diversity indicator?
 - a. WHO and UNICEF
 - b. FAO and UNICEF
 - c. FAO and WHO
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d. World Bank and UNICEF

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Answer : b

Minimum Dietary Diversity (MDD)

- FAO (for women's MDD) and UNICEF (for children's MDD) are the custodian agencies responsible for monitoring MDD.
- MDD tracks whether individuals consume <u>at least 5 out of 10 defined food groups</u> within a 24-hour period.
- The indicator helps assess global nutritional quality beyond just calorie intake.

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- 5) Consider the following statements about the International Symposium on Health Technology Assessment (ISHTA) 2025
 - 1. ISHTA 2025 was organized by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
 - 2. The event focused on integrating Health Technology Assessment (HTA) into policymaking.

International Symposium on Health Technology Assessment (ISHTA), 2025

- ISHTA 2025 was organized by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.
- It focused on using HTA for evidence-based healthcare policies.
- The actual theme was "Bridging Evidence to Policy: Health Technology Assessment for Affordable Healthcare," not "Health for All."

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
