- **Recruitment Reforms** Average recruitment cycle to be significantly reduced from 15 months to 8 months.
- Recruitment exams are now conducted in 13 regional languages.

#### Noma or Cancrum Oris

- Noma or cancrum oris is a severe gangrenous illness of the mouth, *primarily affecting young children*.
- WHO Classification It is recognized as a neglected tropical disease by the World Health Organization (WHO).
- Geographic Prevalence Most common in sub-Saharan Africa, with cases also in Asia and the Americas.
- **Disease Characteristics** Rapid progression leads to severe disfigurement and social stigma.
- **Risk Factors** Malnutrition, poor hygiene, infections, poverty, and weakened immunity, especially in HIV-positive children, increase vulnerability.
