Supreme Court of India Collegium

- The original Constitution of India does not mention the system of a collegium for the appointment of judges to the Supreme Court.
- According to <u>Article 124</u>, Supreme Court judges are appointed by the President of India in consultation with Chief Justice of India (CJI) and other judges that he deems fit.

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- 2) Consider the following statements regarding Inanpith Award
 - 1. The Jnanpith Award is given only to authors who write in regional languages, excluding Hindi and English.

Answer: b

Inanpith Award

- It is *India's highest literary honour*, given annually to Indian writers for their outstanding contribution to literature.
- **Instituted in** 1961.

- Instituted by Sahu Shanti Prasad Jain, founder of <u>Bharatiya Jnanpith</u>, the oldest and most prestigious literary accolade in India.
- It honors authors for their exceptional contributions to literature in Indian languages *listed in the 8th Schedule* (22 languages) of the Constitution.
 - \circ English being included from the 49^{th} award (2013) onwards.

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- 3) What is the primary purpose of the Baanknet Portal?
 - a. To facilitate the e-auction of properties by public sector banks (PSBs).

Baanknet Portal

- It is a revamped <u>e-auction portal</u> that consolidates information on all properties that put up for e-auction by public sector banks (PSBs).
- It is specifically designed to enhance transparency and speed up the process of disposing of **Non-Performing Asset (NPA)** cases.

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- 4) Consider the following statements about anti-dumping measures
 - 1. Anti-dumping duties are levied on goods imported at prices below fair market value in the importing country.
 - 2. The imposition of anti-dumping duties is levied to protect domestic producers from unfair pricing practices.

Anti-dumping Duty

- Anti-dumping duties -It is a tariff imposed on imported goods that are <u>priced below their fair market value</u> in the exporting country, aiming to protect domestic industries from unfair competition.
- Anti-dumping probes are conducted by countries to determine whether domestic industries have been hurt because of a surge in cheap imports.
- Probes are conducted periodically to check for the impact of cheap imports on domestic industries.

Altermagnetism

- This finding holds the promise of improving the performance of electronic devices significantly.
- Boost Operational Speed Of memory devices by as much as a thousand-fold.
 - $\circ\,$ This advancement may pave the way for quicker, more efficient technologies.
 - Altermagnetism is characterized by magnetic units that are arranged in an antiparallel manner.
 - $\circ\,$ Nonetheless, these units display a slightly rotated crystal lattice.
 - This distinctive configuration sets altermagnetism apart from conventional forms of magnetism, merging attributes of both ferromagnets and antiferromagnets into a single material.

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
