- **Dwaraka** It is located on the western tip of the Kathiawar Peninsula and is one of the 4 Char Dhams, India's holiest sites.
- Char Dhams are considered the most important Hindu pilgrimage sites in India they are Rameswaram, Puri, Dwarka, and Badrinath.

# **Atmospheric rivers**

- They are a *narrow, fast-moving band of moisture and wind* like a river in the sky.
- It transports large amounts of water vapour.
- Occurrences They occur all over the world but <u>most common in the</u> mid-latitudes.
- **Formation** They form when large-scale weather patterns create narrow channels of intense moisture transport.
- They <u>start over warm water</u> typically tropical oceans, and are and guided towards the coast <u>by low-level jet streams</u> ahead of cold fronts of extratropical cyclones.
- The **"Pineapple Express**" is one of the strongest known atmospheric rivers, carrying moisture from tropical Pacific near Hawaii to the North American west coast.

- Aim It enhances regional <u>air travel throughout India</u>, particularly targeting tier-2 and tier-3 towns that have limited airport facilities.
- **Developed by -** CSIR-National Aerospace Laboratories (CSIR-NAL) under the Ministry of Science and Technology.

### Chagas disease

- Chagas Disease Also known as American trypanosomiasis, Chagas disease is a *parasitic* illness caused by Trypanosoma cruzi.
- It was discovered in 1909 by Brazilian physician Carlos Chagas.
- **Transmission Pathways** The primary mode of transmission is through the bite or feces of infected triatomine bugs ("kissing bugs").
- Other routes include congenital transmission, blood transfusion, organ transplant, contaminated food, and lab accidents.
- It's not spread by casual contact.
- Disease Progression and Symptoms The acute phase may present with fever, rash, and swollen glands.

# **Operation Meghdoot**

- It was launched in response to Pakistan's Operation to occupy the Siachen Glacier.
- Commemorating Operation Meghdoot Siachen Day specifically marks the anniversary of Operation Meghdoot, launched on April 13, 1984.
- Operation Meghdoot involved the *Army and Air Force* securing the Siachen Glacier, not a naval operation.
