U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID)

- USAID was established through the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961.
- <u>USAID leads U.S. development and humanitarian efforts around the world to enhance and save lives</u>.
- USAID programs combat the spread of disease, address food insecurity, promote democratic reform and support economic growth to alleviate poverty.
- The Agency also provides assistance to countries recovering from disaster and periods of conflict.
- Millennium Challenge Corporation (MCC) Is an <u>independent U.S.</u> <u>foreign assistance</u> agency created in 2004 to reduce poverty and increase living standards by promoting sustainable economic growth and open markets.

Basel, Rotterdam & Stockholm (BRS) Conventions

Basel Convention

- Basel Convention on the Control of Transboundary Movements of Hazardous Wastes and Their Disposal.
- Adopted on 1989, entered into force in 1992.
- **Focus** Controls transboundary movements of hazardous wastes and their disposal.
- Prior informed consent for waste shipments, environmentally sound management, waste minimization.

Rotterdam Convention

- Rotterdam Convention on the Prior Informed Consent Procedure for Certain Hazardous Chemicals and Pesticides in International Trade.
- Adopted on 1998, entered into force in 2004.
- **Focus** Promotes shared responsibility in international trade of hazardous chemicals.

Stockholm Convention

- Stockholm Convention on Persistent Organic Pollutants.
- Adopted on 2001, entered into force in 2004.
- **Focus** Elimination or restriction of production and use of persistent organic pollutants (POPs).
- Targets chemicals that persist in the environment, bioaccumulate, and pose risks to human health and ecosystems.

Microgravity

• Microgravity refers to a condition where the effects of gravity are significantly reduced, creating an apparent state of weightlessness.

- This is often seen in space, where objects in orbit experience a continuous state of freefall.
- Microgravity consistently increases core body temperature.
- It causes faster temperature rise in space than on Earth.

Bagram Airfield

- Bagram Airfield is the *largest airfield in Afghanistan* which is situated at 15 Km from Kabul.
- **Location** Bagram Airfield is located in Parwan province.

National Security Advisory Board (NSAB)

- The NSAB was constituted in December 1998.
- It is an advisory body of eminent persons outside the government to render advice on national security issues referred to it by the NSC.
- The principal function of the NSAB include:
 - $_{\circ}$ To undertake long-term analysis and provide perspectives on national security issues to the National Security Council (NSC).
 - To recommend measures/solutions and policy options on the issues referred to it by the National Security Council, as per a written reply given by the Government in Parliament.
- It draws people of diverse domains including industry, media and civil society, among others.
- The National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS) assist the NSC, NSAB

- and the Strategic Policy Group.The NSAB has no statutory or constitutional status.It is an advisory and non-binding body and its recommendations are not enforceable.
