- Statement 1 is incorrect It was organized by HRA (Hindustan republic army) not HSRA.
- It aims to Looting the money to buy arms for their revolution against the British government.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** Ram Prasad Bismil, Chandrasekar Azad, Ashfaqulla Khan, Thakur Roshan Singh and Rajendranath Lahiri are among the personalities involved in this action, <u>but not Bhaqat Singh</u>.
- Bhagat Singh later joined in HRA after the kakori train incident.

- 2) Advanced Liquid Processing System (ALPS) is primarily used to purify water contaminated with?
 - a. Heavy metals
 - b. Microplastics
 - c. Radioactive materials
 - d. Sewage water

Answer: c

Explanation

- **Option is (c) correct ALPS** is a pumping and filtration system, which uses a series of chemical reactions to **remove 62 radionuclides** from contaminated water.
- However, <u>ALPS is not able to remove tritium</u> from the contaminated water.
- **Tritium** is *an isotope of hydrogen*, and water containing tritium has chemical features almost identical to water with ordinary hydrogen.
- Technologies exist that can recover tritium when it is highly concentrated in small amounts of water, for example at nuclear fusion facilities.

- However, the stored water at the Fukushima Daiichi NPS has a low concentration of tritium in a large volume of water and so the existing technologies are not applicable.
- It is relevant because of new proposed Ocean model for Fukushima's wastewater release
- 3) With reference to the Rare Earth Elements (REE), consider the following statements
 - 1. REE group of 17 minerals essential to make powerful magnets, camera, telescope lenses, catalytic converters in cars, making control rods in nuclear reactors.
 - 2. Australia ranks as the world's largest producer of rare earths.
 - 3. Minerals Security Partnership (MSP) is a EU-led international alliance of 14 countries, including India, to secure critical mineral supply chains.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct -** It is a group of 17 minerals essential to modern technology.
- These are relatively abundant but costly and complex to extract particularly heavy rare earths such as terbium, fetch high prices.
- Statement 2 is incorrect <u>China is the largest</u> currently accounts for over 60% of global rare earth mining and nearly 90% of processing output.
- Australia ranks as the world's fourth-largest producer of rare earths.
- <u>India holds third-largest</u> reserves globally about 6.9 million tonnes in monazite-rich sands along the coasts of Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Kerala and Rajasthan's Jalore & Barmer districts.
- Statement 3 is incorrect <u>MSP is US-led alliance</u> of 14 countries, established in 2022 to secure critical mineral supply chains.
- 4) Financial Fraud Risk Indicator (FRI) recently seen in news introduced by?

- Option (b) is correct Financial Fraud Risk Indicator was Introduced by <u>Department of Telecommunications (DoT)</u> to strengthen Cyber Fraud Prevention.
- It is a risk-based metric that classifies a mobile number to have been associated with Medium, High, or Very High risk of financial fraud.
- This classification is an outcome of inputs obtained from: National Cybercrime Reporting Portal (NCRP), DoT's Chakshu facility and Digital Intelligence Platform (DIP) and Intelligence shared by banks and financial institutions.
- It empowers stakeholders such as banks, NBFCs, and UPI service providers to prioritize enforcement and take additional customer protection measures in case a mobile number have high risk.
- 5) Which of the following ministry does 'RAMP scheme' related to?
