Explanation



- Statements 1 and 2 are correct It is is a mandatory institutional redressal mechanism to address complaints of sexual harassment at the workplace.
- Statement 3 is incorrect Aggrieved women can raise a complaint within <u>3 months</u> (not 12 months).
- **Additional information** ICC is headed by Presiding Officer, who is to be a woman employed at a senior level at the workplace.
- At least 2 members should be employees preferably committed to the cause of women or who have had experience in social work or have legal knowledge.
- ICC has similar powers of a civil court and the enquiry will be completed within 90 days after filing of complaint.

- Additional information Clearance of GEAC is mandatory for the environmental release of Genetically Modified (GM) crops.
- It functions under Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change (MoEF&CC).
- The committee or any persons authorized by it has powers to take punitive action under the Environment Protection Act.

- DRI works under the Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs, <u>Ministry of Finance</u>, Government of India.
- It is tasked with <u>detecting and curbing smuggling of contraband, including drug trafficking and illicit international trade</u> in wildlife and environmentally sensitive items.
- Other functions also include combating commercial frauds related to international trade and evasion of customs duty etc.
- 4) With reference to **Bloom Syndrome** disease recently seen in news, consider the following
 - 1. It is a rare genetic disorder, characterised by short stature and blood-related complications, and carries a risk of blood cancers.

Explanation

- Both statements 1 and 2 are correct.
- Bloom Syndrome is an <u>autosomal recessive genetic disorder</u>, meaning a person must inherit 2 copies of the **mutated BLM gene**, one from each parent.
- The BLM gene provides instructions for making a protein called a *RecQ helicase*, which is crucial for DNA stability.

- 2. The pass is a major pilgrimage route for Hindus traveling to Mount Kailash and Lake Manasarovar in Tibet.

- **Option C** is **correct.** Nepal recently objected to India and China announcing the reopening of border trade through the Lipulekh Pass, citing its claims over the region.
- **Zoji La** It is Located at 3,528 m on the Srinagar-Leh highway, gateway between Kashmir and Ladakh, which is crucial for military and trade.
- Nathu La pass It is at Sikkim-Tibet border at 4,310 m, significant for India-China trade and part of ancient Silk Route.
- Mana Pass It is at Uttarakhand-Tibet border at 5,632 m, highest motorable pass.
