- Recently, researchers recorded a *new orchid plant* in Vijoynagar, Arunachal Pradesh.
- The Gastrochilus pechei was known to bloom only in Myanmar.
- It is called with common name as Peche's Lip Orchid.
- Characteristics It is a small, epiphytic orchid with a single, leathery leaf and a short stem.
- It has many leathery, flat leaves that sheathe at the base, with an unequally bilobed apex.
- The inflorescence is lateral, relatively short, sub-umbellate, and bears a few to many flowers.

- Neglected tropical diseases (NTDs) are a diverse group of conditions caused by a variety of pathogens, including viruses, bacteria, parasites, fungi and toxins and associated with devastating health, social and economic consequences.
- Statement 2 is correct <u>Increased heat and humidity induced by climate Change</u> creating favourable habitats for venomous snakes.

• It increases human-snake interactions across rural and urban areas could present new challenges for public health and medical management

- It focuses on artillery operations, joint firepower planning, and enhancing interoperability through the use of modern equipment and simulation.
- **Option c is incorrect** It is irrelevant, there is no such initiative.
- Option d is correct <u>Operation SWARNA</u> (Swarnamukhi Waterbody Action for River and Nala Awareness).
- Recently, the Tirupati Urban Development Authority (TUDA) has announced Operation SWARNA <u>to</u> rescue the River Swarnamukhi.
- The initiatives objectives include rescuing River Swarnamukhi from encroachments.
