- Statement 2 is incorrect the programme delivers psychiatric substances to <u>elderly/senior</u> <u>citizens</u> at their door step (not all citizens) to bridge gaps in mental health.
- A dedicated team comprising psychiatrists, psychologists, and nurses who will conduct home visits, provide follow-up assessments, counselling and further assists to elderly.
- Additional information <u>Post-diagnostic Dementia Care Centre</u> is an initiative launched by NIMHANS.
- It is to provide structured support to families after a dementia diagnosis, a stage where most are left to cope alone.

- 3 and 4 are correct Mount Kerinci, also spelled Kerintji, is an <u>active stratovolcano</u> and the highest mountain in Sumatra, Indonesia.
- **Mount Krakatoa**, also transcribed Krakatau, is a *caldera* in the Sunda Strait between the islands of Java and Sumatra in the Indonesian province of Lampung.
