Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - Indian startup, Muse Wearables has partnered with the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) to launch India's 1st wearable payments ecosystem.
- Ring One is an advanced smart ring for instant, secure, and contactless payments. It claims to be India's 1st secure element tokenization (SET) platform.
- This ecosystem enables payments with a simple tap on any near field communication (NFC)-enabled point-of-sale (PoS) terminal, without the need for any phone, card, or wallet. **So 2 is incorrect.**
- Payments are functional only when the Ring One is being worn. If the ring is removed, transactions are instantly disabled.

2) What is **Mission Dristhi** recently seen news?

- **Mission Dristhi** is the **world's 1st multi-sensor Earth observation (EO) satellite**. It is India's largest privately built satellite and also the highest-resolution satellite developed in the country.
- It aims to achieve near real-time Earth observation for global applications. It is planned by

Bengaluru based space startup ***GalaxEye***

- This mission is to be launched in 2026, this constellation program comprising 8-12 satellites to be launched successively until 2029.

- This species is relatively less vocal and have rarely been known to howl.
- **Statements 2 and 3 are incorrect** - They lives in semi-arid and arid areas.
- It lacks the Himalayan wolf's thick winter coat because it lives in warmer conditions.
- Indian wolves are **carnivores** and prey mainly on antelopes, rodents, hares, and raccoons. Indian wolves are **monogamous** and mate for life.

Explanation

- Recently, UNESCO launches the World's 1st Virtual Museum of Stolen Cultural Objects at a global scale at **MONDIACULT 2025, in Barcelona, Spain.**
- The museum is an innovative digital platform -
 - to raise awareness of the illicit trafficking of cultural property; and
 - help facilitate the return of cultural artifacts to their countries of origin.
- It is a "first-of-its-kind" initiative that uses technology to highlight the stories of objects lost to looting, particularly during the colonial era.
- It was launched at UNESCO's World Conference on Cultural Policies and Sustainable Development (MONDIACULT 2025).

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
