  - Zakat (almsgiving),
  - o Sawm (fasting during Ramadan), and
  - Hajj (pilgrimage to Mecca)
- Hajj was taking place <u>between 4th to 9th June 2025 in</u> the Gregorian Calendar, depending on the sighting of the moon.
