Explanation



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- **All the given statements 1, 2, 3 are correct.**
- **Hajj** is the fifth pillar of Islam, a mandatory pilgrimage to Mecca that every physically and financially able adult Muslim must complete at least once in their lifetime.
- The pilgrimage is a sacred journey following the ritual pattern *established by the **Prophet Muhammad***.
- **5 Pillars of Islam** -
 - Shahada (profession of faith),
 - Salah (prayer five times a day),
 - Zakat (almsgiving),
 - Sawm (fasting during Ramadan), and
 - Hajj (pilgrimage to Mecca)
- Hajj was taking place between 4th to 9th June 2025 in the Gregorian Calendar, depending on the sighting of the moon.

2) Which of the following statements are correct?

1. India ranks 4th in total renewable energy capacity in the world.
2. India ranks 4th in solar power generation in the world.
3. India ranks 3rd in wind power generation in the world.

Answer : b

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - India is the **fourth-largest** country in the world for **total renewable energy capacity**, with 257 GW of installed capacity as of late October 2025.
 - This is a significant increase from 81 GW in 2014.
- **Statements 2 and 3 are incorrect** - India ranks 4th in total renewable energy capacity; **3rd in solar power generation**; 4th in wind power.
- India's solar capacity has surpassed 120 GW, progressing toward 500 GW by 2030.
- **Future goals** - By 2050, India aims to be a global hub for solar innovation, manufacturing, and knowledge exchange.

- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - It is the **indigenously designed & developed, multi-band communication satellite** for Indian Navy.

- It will provide telecommunication coverage across the Indian Ocean region between the Navy's ships, submarines, aircraft, and Maritime Operations Centres.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - Its weight is about 4,400 kg, India's **heaviest** communication satellite to date launched to GTO from Indian soil.
- Launch vehicle is Launch Vehicle Mark 3 (LVM3) into the Geosynchronous Transfer Orbit (GTO). This Mission life is about 12-15 years.
- GSAT-7R is a replacement and upgrade for the existing GSAT-7 (Rukmini) satellite, which was nearing the end of its operational life.
