Explanation

- Recently, **UNICEF** has released "*The State of the World's Children 2025: Ending Child Poverty - Our Shared Imperative*" report on World Children's Day (November 20, 2025).
- It highlighted that more than 1 in 5 children in low and middle-income countries (about 400 million globally) are severely deprived in at least two basic needs out of 6 - education, health, housing, nutrition, sanitation, clean water.
- Substantial levels of child poverty exist around the world, even in high income countries (around 50 million children live in poverty).

- **Nathu La** (4,310 m) located in **Sikkim**. It is a Historic trade route; one of two passes (with Jelep La) linking Sikkim & Tibet
- **Shipki La** (4,500-5,000 m) located at Himachal Pradesh (Kinnaur) -Tibet. It has restricted access; used for limited cross-border trade.
- **Bomdi La** (4,331 m) is located at West Kameng district, Arunachal Pradesh. It historically

connected the Arunachal Pradesh with Lhasa, the capital of Tibet.

Explanation

- **Option a is the correct answer.**
- **Leptospirosis** is a **zoonotic disease**, caused by the bacteria **Leptospira**. It is one of the **neglected tropical disease**.
- It is common in **tropical/warm climates with heavy rainfall** (South/Southeast Asia, Oceania, Caribbean, Latin America, sub-Saharan Africa).
- It spread through water or soil contaminated by the urine of infected animals, such as rodents.
- As per National Centre for Disease Control (NCDC) in India, it is endemic in coastal & flood-prone states (Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Gujarat, Maharashtra).

Explanation

Answer : c

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - Aluminum is made from the ore bauxite, which is first refined into alumina and then smelted into aluminum metal using a powerful electric current.
- To create different alloys, aluminum is mixed with other metals, such as copper or manganese, to give it specific properties like increased strength or corrosion resistance
- **Statement 2 is correct** - In recent years, there has been a surge in India imports of Aluminium from China, Russia, ASEAN nations and the Middle East.
