- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - **Article 129** states that the Supreme Court shall be a court of record and shall have all the powers of such a court including the power to punish for contempt of itself.
- **Article 136** deals with special leave petition.
- It gives the Supreme Court a very wide, discretionary jurisdiction to entertain appeals from any court/tribunal in the territory of India (with limited exceptions).
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** - A Special Leave Petition (SLP) can be filed against judgments from High Courts and tribunals (except those under the armed forces).
- **Statement 3 is incorrect** - The **time limit for SLP** to be filed is generally 90 days from the date of the judgment, but if a High Court refuses a certificate of fitness for appeal, the SLP must be filed within 60 days of that refusal.

- **Option a is correct answer** - India's state-owned Bharat Electronics Limited (BEL) and the French firm Safran Electronics and Defence (SED) recently signed a joint venture cooperation agreement (JVCA) to produce HAMMER.

- **HAMMER** is a modular guidance and propulsion kit fitted onto conventional bombs to make them Precise (GPS/INS or laser-guided), Long-range, and All-weather capable.
- It is also known as a **glide bomb**. It was developed by **France**.

- **Option b is the correct answer.**
- The Constitution of India was framed by a Constituent Assembly set up under the **Cabinet Mission Plan of 1946**.
- The Assembly held its first meeting on **December 9, 1946**, and elected **Dr. Sachhidanand Sinha**, the oldest member of the Assembly as the Provisional President.
- On December 11, 1946, the Assembly elected **Dr Rajendra Prasad** as its permanent Chairman.
- The Constituent Assembly set up 13 committees for framing the constitution, including a Drafting Committee under the Chairmanship of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar.
