1) With reference to **National Commission for Minorities (NCM)**, which of the following is correct?

- It is established as a statutory body under National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992.
- All the members are drawn from diverse minority communities.
- Each member serves 4 years term.
- It can impose punishment if any party found guilty of atrocities related to minorities.

Answer : b

Explanation

- a is incorrect** - NCM established in 1978 under a Ministry of Home Affairs resolution.
- Later by enacting the National Commission for Minorities Act, 1992, the commission **became a statutory body**.
- b is correct** - All members of the commission are drawn from the diverse minority backgrounds.
- c is incorrect** - Each member serves 3 year term.
- d is incorrect** - NCM has quasi-judicial power and enjoys powers equivalent to a civil court under the Code of Civil Procedure but it cannot award punishment or enforce its decisions directly.
- It acts as an advisor, and researcher by evaluating progress, monitoring safeguards, addressing complaints, suggesting policies, and reporting to the government to protect minority rights.

Explanation

- Statement 1 is correct** - IIDEA, established in **1995**, is an intergovernmental organization that supports to strengthen democratic institutions and electoral processes worldwide.
- It has been granted **UN observer** status in 2003. Began with 14 founding states in 1995; now has

35 Member States and 2 Observers (US, Japan) from all regions of the world.

- India joined International IDEA in 1995 as a founding member.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** – **Each December**, Member States elect new Chairs and Vice Chairs, as the Council's **Chairmanship rotates annually by region**.

- It is **based at Visakhapatnam**, operating on the Eastern Seaboard.
- It is the **7th and final OPV in a series**, highlighting indigenous shipbuilding capabilities.
