- Option b is the correct *Mahad satyagaraha* became the site of India's 1st organised human rights movement, led by Dr. B. R. Ambedkar in 1927.
- Dr. B. R. Ambedkar organized about 2,500 Dalits in a march to the Chavdar Tank in Mahad, where Dalits had long been denied access to this public water source.
- In a bold act, Ambedkar drank water from the tank, symbolising equality. This triggered strong protests from caste Hindus.

Explanation

- Statements 1 and 2 are correct AstroSat is *India's first dedicated multi-wavelength space observatory*.
- It was launched in **2015** by **ISRO** in collaboration with International partners like Canada and UK using PSLV-C30 (XL) rocket launch vehicle.
- It aims to study celestial sources in X-ray, optical and UV spectral bands simultaneously.
- The mission life is 5 years, but it continues to provide valuable data till now.
- **Statement 3 is correct** It has 5 scientific payloads i.e,
 - Ultra Violet Imaging Telescope (UVIT),
 - Large Area X-ray Proportional Counter (LAXPC),
 - Cadmium-Zinc-Telluride Imager (CZTI),
 - Soft X-ray Telescope (SXT) and
 - Scanning Sky Monitor (SSM)
- Ultra-Violet Imaging Telescope (UVIT) is India's 1st ultraviolet (UV) space telescope, unique globally for combining a large field of view with high spatial resolution(<1.5 arcseconds).
- It is the only operational telescope (<u>besides the Hubble Space Telescope</u>) capable of observing in the far-ultraviolet spectrum.

- 4) Who has the power to inclusion/exclusion from SC/ST list?

Answer: b

Explanation

- **Option b is correct Parliament** has the **sole power** to include or exclude any caste/tribe from the lists through legislation, overriding any later executive action.
- A Bill is introduced in Parliament to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Castes) Order, 1950 or the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950.
- The Bill must be passed by both Houses of Parliament.
- Under **Articles 341 & 342**, the <u>President issues the final notification, giving legal effect</u> to the inclusion/exclusion.
