Explanation

- Statement 1 is incorrect Dr. Rajendra Prasad was the <u>first elected President</u> of the Constituent Assembly of India, chosen on December 11, 1946, after Dr. Sachidananda Sinha served as the temporary president for the first meeting.
- Dr. Rajendra Prasad led the assembly in drafting India's Constitution and later became the first President of independent India.
- Statement 2 is correct Constituent assembly incorpora both elected and nominated members:
 - **Elected Members** Representatives from the existing provincial legislatures were elected through a system of proportional representation.
 - **Nominated Members** The various princely states appointed their representatives directly, resulting in nominated members for their seats.

- Bangladesh criticized this, calling it an infringement of cultural heritage, since Tangail is geographically in Bangladesh.

- Statement 1 is correct Deepavali or Diwali is a five-day Hindu festival, also known an Indian festival of lights. 'Deepa' means lamp or light and 'Vali' means string or row, and Deepavali means rows of lights.
- Central theme the festival of **Triumph of good over evil**.
- In North India It celebrates the return of Lord Rama to his kingdom Ayodhya after 14 years of exile and his victory over the demon Ravana.
- In South India It marks the day Lord Krishna and his wife Satyabhama defeated the demon Narakasura.
