Explanation

- **Option c is the correct answer.**
- Shrouded in a heavy blanket of fog, the **Taj Mahal** seemed to disappear as dense mist engulfed Agra, drastically reducing visibility across the city.
- It was designated as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1983.
- **Decorative features of Taj Mahal includes-**
 - It uses White Makrana marble, red Sikri sandstone with inlay of precious & semi-precious stones;
 - **Pietra dura** - Inlay of **semiprecious stones** (lapis lazuli, jade, crystal, turquoise, amethyst) in floral/geometric designs;
 - Arabesque calligraphy (Quranic verses);
 - High and low relief carvings; and
 - Extensive jali (lattice screen) works.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - AIWS is a rare **neurological condition** that causes temporary distortions in how a person observes size, distance, body image, and time.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - Symptoms of the AIWS include
 - Objects appear larger or smaller than reality (micropsia/macropsia).
 - Distorted sense of distance (things seem closer/farther).
- **Duration** of episodes are usually brief, shorter, lasting from a few minutes to about half an hour.
- **Statement 3 is correct** - There is **no specific treatment**; it focuses on treating the underlying cause.
- Infections resolve naturally, migraines need preventive care, epilepsy/lesions require targeted therapy, and reassurance is essential.

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- **Statement 1 is correct** - **Zero FIR** is a type of FIR that **can be filed at any police station**, regardless of the jurisdiction where the crime occurred.
- It can be filed either by victim or informant.
- **First Information Report (FIR)** can be filed only in the police station under whose area the crime occurred.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - **Zero FIR** introduced in 2013 on the recommendation of the Justice Verma Committee to make police more responsive in cases of sexual violence and other serious crimes.

 - 10 ASEAN nations (Brunei, Cambodia, Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Myanmar, Philippines, Singapore, **Thailand**, Vietnam)
 - plus Australia, **China**, **Japan**, South Korea, and **New Zealand**.
- It forms the **world's largest trade bloc by GDP and population**, aimed at reducing tariffs and boosting regional trade.
- India has Free Trade Agreements with all RCEP countries except China, once FTA with New Zealand comes into effect.
