3) Live Events Development Cell (LEDC) is introduced by which one of the following?

- The **Live Events Development Cell (LEDC)** acts as a single-window facilitator for the sector, bringing together representatives from Central and State governments, industry associations, music rights societies, and major event companies.
- LEDC was introduced by the **Ministry of Information and Broadcasting** in July 2025.
- Its goal is to achieve the full economic and cultural potential of concerts and live events in the country.
- It aims to facilitate the expansion of the "concert economy", boosting employment and tourism in the country.
- In 2024, the organised live events market was valued at Rs.20,861 crore, **reflecting a 15% growth rate** that surpasses several traditional media segments.
- With an expected CAGR of 18%, the sector is positioned to establish India as a leading global live entertainment destination by 2030.

4) What does the **W Ursae Majoris (W UMa)** best describes?

- **W Ursae Majoris (W UMa)** stars are short-period, dumbbell-shaped binaries in which the two stars are in contact.
- The stars are so close that they share a single outer atmosphere while orbiting each other.
- These stars serve as "natural laboratories" by enabling precise measurement of fundamental parameters such as
  - Mass, radius, and temperature, which are essential for testing theories of stellar evolution.

5) What is **Beni greenlet** recently seen in news?

- a. Bird species
- b. Antelope

## Explanation

- The Beni greenlet is a newly confirmed bird species, characterised by its small size and greenish-grey plumage.
- The species has a small body with predominantly greenish-grey upperparts, a paler grey to whitish belly and throat, short, rounded wings, and a relatively short tail.
- It has dark eyes with a faint or indistinct eye-ring.
- It inhabits tropical moist lowland forests of northern Bolivia, primarily occupying the canopy and forest edges.
