- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - *Pravasi Bharatiya Diwas* is organized by the Ministry of External Affairs and initially held annually but since 2015, organised once every 2 years.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - It aims to recognise and honour the contribution of the Indian diaspora to India's development and to strengthen their engagement with the motherland.
- It is celebrated in commemoration to the return of Mahatma Gandhi from South Africa to India in Jan 09, 1915.

2) Consider the following statements about **Kathputli Puppetry**

1. It is a type of string puppet carved from wood and dressed in bright, colourful costumes.
2. The origins of puppetry date back to the Indus Valley Civilisation around 2500 B.C.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - The name Kathputli comes from kath (wood) and putli (doll). It is one of Rajasthan's oldest folk-art forms.

- It is a type of **string puppet** carved from wood and dressed in bright, colourful costumes and is manufactured in Kathputli Nagar in Jaipur's 'Pink City'.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - The origins of puppetry date back to the Indus Valley Civilisation around 2500 B.C., where archaeologists discovered a terracotta doll with a detachable head.
- The earliest evidence of puppets has also been traced to Egypt, dating to around 2000 B.C.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - It is a sleek, medium-sized otter with short limbs, webbed paws, and a flattened tail.
- It is found in freshwater-rich areas such as rivers, wetlands, lakes, swamps, and rice paddies.
 - Prefer shallow and placid waters.
 - Though found near coastal saltwater, they require nearby freshwater sources.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** - India is home to 3 types of otters out of the 13 species of otters found worldwide i.e.,
 - Eurasian Otter (*Lutra lutra*);
 - Smooth-coated Otter (*Lutra perspicillata*)
 - Small-clawed otter (*Aonyx cinereus*).

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** – IRENA is an intergovernmental organization, founded in 2009, supports countries in their transition to a sustainable energy future.
- Presently, IRENA has 171 Members (170 Countries and the European Union).
- **Statements 2 and 3 are correct** – Its headquarters located at Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates (UAE).
- India is among its founding members.

5) The term **Bagurumba Dwhou** recently seen in news is?

- Archaeological site
- Traditional dance
- Puppet making method
- Animal capturing technique used by tribes

Answer : b

Explanation

- **Option b is the correct answer** - *Bagurumba Dohou* refers to a historic, mass-scale cultural performance of the traditional Bagurumba dance of the Bodo community in Assam.
- It is often called as the “**butterfly dance**”, for its graceful and flowing movements inspired by butterflies, birds, leaves and flowers.
- The Bodo women perform the dance wearing colorful handwoven Dokhna, Jwmgra (Fasra), and Aronai.
- Performances are usually in groups, arranged in circles or lines.
