2) The **Chhari-Dhandh Wetland** located at which one of the following states?

- **Option a is correct** - **Chhari-Dhandh Wetland** is declared as a Ramsar site on January 31, 2026, **Gujarat's 5th Ramsar Site** and the 1st in Kachchh.
- It is spread over 22,700 hectares, it lies at the confluence of desert, grassland, and wetland landscapes, supporting diverse flora and fauna.
- It attracts thousands of migratory birds annually, notably the Grey Hypocolius and surveys recorded over 50,000 waterbirds, including 40,000 cranes at one site.

### Explanation

- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - **RIN Mutiny** is revolt by Indian sailors of the Royal Indian Navy on February 18, 1946, against British rule, primarily in Mumbai (then Bombay), Maharashtra at the shore establishment **HMIS Talwar**.
- Although it eventually spread to other naval centers like Karachi and Calcutta (West Bengal), its epicenter and origin remained Bombay.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - The causes of the mutiny are poor treatment, lack of compensation, and racial discrimination towards Indian soldiers.

Answer : c

### Explanation

- **All three are correct - Ayyangar Commission** (1949) - Early official study on denotified tribes.
- Based on its recommendations, the discriminatory Criminal Tribes Act (CTA) of 1871 was repealed in 1952, leading to these communities being "De-notified".
- **Renke Commission** (2008) - First National Commission on Denotified, Nomadic and Semi-Nomadic Tribes.
- **Idate Commission** (2017) - Identified around 1,200 DNT communities assimilated in SC/ST/OBC Lists.
  - Identified 268 unclassified DNT communities.
  - Anthropological Survey of India recommended classification of these communities.
