Explanation



- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - Base year revised from 2012 to **2024** *to reflect structural changes in consumption, urbanisation, and digitalisation.*
- **Statement 2 is correct** - The Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (**MoSPI**) releases the Consumer Price Index (CPI) *on a monthly basis.*
- The first release of the new series occurred on February 12, 2026, for the month of January 2026.
- **Statement 3 is correct** - [New CPI Index](#) revises CPI item basket and updates weights using the latest Household Consumption Expenditure Survey (HCES) of 2023-24 data.
- **Basket of Items expanded** -
 - Weighted items increased from 299 to 358 items.
 - Service items increased from 40 to 50.

2) Consider the following statements about **Urban Challenge Fund (UCF)**

1. UCF is a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme administered by Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.
2. It aims to support urban infrastructure projects and boost market-driven urban development.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - The [Urban Challenge Fund \(UCF\)](#) is a new Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) approved by the Union Cabinet in February 2026.
- It is administered and monitored by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA).
- **Statement 2 is correct** - The primary objective of the UCF is to support transformative and bankable urban infrastructure projects through a competitive "challenge-mode".
- It marks a paradigm shift from traditional grant-based funding to market-driven urban development,
 - Requiring cities to leverage market finance (like municipal bonds and PPPs) for at least 50% of the project cost.

- The first phase involved the translocation of eight African cheetahs from Namibia to Kuno National Park in Madhya Pradesh.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** - The project is implemented by the **National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA)**, which is a statutory body under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (MoEFCC).

4) Which of the following statements about **speed breeding** is incorrect?

- a. It is a set of techniques that creates new crop varieties using the transgenic processes.

Explanation

- **Option a is correct answer** - **Speed breeding** is primarily a **non-transgenic method** that *accelerates the plant's natural growth cycle* through environmental manipulation.

- While it can be combined with advanced tools like gene editing (transgenics) or genomic selection.
- The core "speed breeding" methodology itself relies on optimizing light and temperature in controlled environments to trigger faster flowering and seed maturity.
