Q3) The Immigration and Foreigners Act, 2025 empowers the Government to:

1. Establish a Bureau of Immigration to regulate entry, stay, and movement of foreigners.
2. Mandate registration of all foreigners within 14 days of arrival, regardless of visa duration.
3. Authorize police officers of Head Constable rank or above to arrest offenders without warrant.

Q4) With reference to the formation of Telangana, consider the following statements:

1. Telangana became India's 29th State on 2 June 2014, carved out of Andhra Pradesh.
2. It was created through a constitutional amendment under Article 368.
3. Hyderabad was designated as the joint capital of Telangana and Andhra Pradesh for 10 years.

Explanation: Telangana attained statehood on 2 June 2014, becoming India's 29th State (1). It was created by Parliamentary legislation — Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014 — under Article 3, not by constitutional amendment under Article 368 (so 2 is incorrect). Hyderabad was the joint capital for 10 years, now sole capital of Telangana.

Q5. Case Study Type

A Victim of an Organized trafficking ring was rescued in one of the North Indian states, but investigations reveal that the victim belong to a Neighbouring South Asian Country. To Ensure her safe repatriation & to share intel with the law enforcement authorities of the victim's mother country, the Ministry of External Affairs invokes a regional treaty.
