1) With reference to **Viksit Vibrant Village Program, 2026**, consider the following statements

1. It is a pioneering youth-led initiative aimed at promoting sustainable development in India's border villages.
2. It is implemented solely by the Ministry of Home Affairs.

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - The Viksit Vibrant Village Program 2026 is a pioneering youth-led initiative designed as an experiential learning and development program.
- Under this scheme, youth volunteers (selected via the Mera Yuva Bharat / MY Bharat platform) are sent for residential stays in border villages to promote grassroots engagement.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect** - The primary implementing agency is the Department of Youth Affairs under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports via the MY Bharat platform.
- While it is executed in close collaboration with the Ministry of Home Affairs and the Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP), the nodal implementation is not by the Ministry of Home Affairs alone.

2) With reference to **North Eastern Council**, consider the following statements

1. Ministry of Home Affairs acts as the nodal ministry for the council.
2. Union home minister is the ex-officio chairperson.
3. Sikkim is not part under its original composition.

Select the correct statements using the codes below:

Answer : b

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is incorrect** - The nodal ministry for the council is the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER)

- **Statement 2 is correct** - The Union Home Minister officially serves as the ex-officio Chairperson of the North Eastern Council.
- **Statement 3 is correct** - Under its original composition in the North Eastern Council Act, 1971, Sikkim was not a member.
- Sikkim was officially added as the eighth member state later through the North Eastern Council (Amendment) Act, 2002.

3) With reference to the **Unified Payments Interface (UPI)** in India, which one of the following statements is correct?

- It allows for peer-to-peer and peer-to-merchant transactions exclusively through linked savings and current bank accounts.
- It is a real-time payment system developed and entirely regulated by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) as a sovereign entity.
- It supports cross-border interoperability, allowing Indian users to make payments in select foreign countries using local QR codes.

Explanation

- Recently, NPCI International & ACLEDA Bank launch cross-border UPI payments in Cambodia via KHQR, Cambodia's National QR Code.
- It making Cambodia the 9th nation to adopt UPI services.
- **C is correct** - National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has actively expanded UPI globally.
- Indian travelers can seamlessly scan local QR codes to make real-time merchant payments in select international destinations like France, Singapore, the UAE, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and Mauritius.
- **a is incorrect** - It is no longer exclusive to traditional savings and current accounts.
- UPI has evolved to support overdraft accounts, prepaid wallets (Prepaid Payment Instruments or PPIs), and even credit lines linked directly to the system.
- **b is incorrect** - UPI was developed by the National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
- **d is incorrect** - The integration of credit cards on UPI actually started with India's homegrown RuPay network.

4) The **Kalpasar Project** is proposed to be set up at which of the following areas?

- North eastern states bordering with Myanmar
- Ladakh

Explanation

- **Option d is correct** - The Kalpasar Project is proposed to be set up at the Gulf of Khambhat.
- It is also known as the Gulf of Khambhat Development Project, it is a multipurpose initiative by the Government of Gujarat designed to build a massive dam across the gulf.
- Its primary goal is to create one of the world's largest freshwater coastal reservoirs to provide water for irrigation, domestic, and industrial use in the water-stressed Saurashtra region.

Q5) A data analyst of medical is categorizing a patient who is suffering with a continues bad cough which is lasting since 4 weeks, intermittent chest pain during breathing, coughing up mucus streaked with blood, and unexplained weight loss.

Explanation

The patient shows common signs of active TB (cough lasting more than 3 weeks, chest pain, coughing blood/mucus, and weight loss). Since it involves the respiratory system, it is classified as pulmonary.
