- 1) Which one of the following acts as the nodal agency for National Testing Agency (NTA)?
- Ministry of Home Affairs
  - Ministry of Education
  - Ministry of Science and Technology

Answer : b

### Explanation

- **Option b is correct** - The National Testing Agency (NTA) operates as an autonomous testing organization under the Department of Higher Education within the *Ministry of Education*.
- NTA was set up to relieve CBSE of heavy testing duties, which helps CBSE to focus on school education, curriculum design, and academic evaluation.

- 2) Which among the following states is **not part** of proposal to develop four semi-greenfield Namoo Cities under the Regional Plan 2041?

- Madhya Pradesh
- Delhi
- Haryana
- Rajasthan

Answer : a

### Explanation

- **Option a is incorrect.**
- The meeting of the National Capital Region Planning Board (NCRPB) approved the proposal to develop four semi-greenfield Namoo Cities under the Regional Plan 2041.
- The 4 cities are mandated to be distributed equally — one each across the four states (*Delhi, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, and Rajasthan*).

- Crop Residue Management (CRM) Scheme is implemented under Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY).
- It is centrally sponsored scheme.

Answer : c

### Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct** - The CRM Scheme is implemented as a component of the **Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY)**.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - It operates as a **Centrally Sponsored Scheme**.
- The funding is shared between the Centre and the participating states (usually a 60:40 ratio), with 100% central funding for NCT Delhi.

4) The Maharana Pratap recently seen in news associated with which part of kingdoms of India?

- a. North Western India
- b. North Eastern India
- c. Central India
- d. South India

Answer : a

### Explanation

- **Option a is correct** - Maharana Pratap (1540 -1597) was the 13th Rajput king. He is associated with Mewar, northwestern Rajasthan.
- He was known for His lifelong military resistance against the expansionist policies of the Mughals (Akbar).
- **Historic milestones** - Battle of Haldighati (1576) - Fought in a narrow mountain pass against a massive Mughal force led by Raja Man Singh of Amer.
