1) The term “Libex” recently seen in news?

- a. Coffee variety
- b. Satellite

Answer : a

Explanation

- **Option a is correct** – “**Libex**” has recently made news as the name of a new, climate-resilient coffee hybrid (*Coffea x libex*) created to survive extreme heat.
- The plant was bred by researchers using a cross of *Liberica* to withstand warming temperatures and yield better beans.

2) With reference to the recently launched MFI Credit Registry, consider the following statements:

1. It aims to reduce defaults by helping lenders identify borrowers with multiple loans and curb over-indebtedness.
2. The registry has been launched by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and is mandatory for all microfinance institutions operating in India.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

- a. 1 only
- b. 2 only
- c. Both 1 and 2
- d. Neither 1 nor 2

Answer : a

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct.** The MFI Credit Registry enables participating Section 8 (not-for-profit) MFIs to share borrower loan and repayment data.
- It integrates this data with credit bureau information to generate a consolidated credit report.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect.** The registry was launched by Recordent, developed in consultation with Sa-Dhan (the RBI-appointed self-regulatory body).

3) Consider the following statements about **Golden Langur**

1. It is an Old-World monkey, known primarily for its distinct, leaf-eating dietary adaptations.
2. Its IUCN status is critically endangered.

Select the correct statements using the codes below:

- a. 1 only
- b. 2 only
- c. Both 1 and 2
- d. Neither 1 nor 2

Answer : a

Explanation

- **Statement 1 is correct.** The Golden Langur (*Trachypithecus geei*) is an Old-World monkey belonging to the subfamily Colobinae.
- They are highly specialized folivores (leaf-eaters) with a multi-chambered stomach to ferment and digest tough cellulose.
- **Statement 2 is incorrect.** Its IUCN status is classified as Endangered.

4) The Operation Amistad launched by India to offer humanitarian assistance to?

- a. Venezuela
- b. Iran
- c. Israel
- d. Bangladesh

Answer : a

Explanation

- **Option a is correct** - India launched Operation Amistad to provide humanitarian assistance and disaster relief to **Venezuela** following devastating earthquakes.

5) Under the New Education Policy 2020 framework, Reshma joins a 4-year undergraduate degree program. After successfully completing her second year she is forced to leave her college due to financial issue at home.

What certification will Reshma receive upon her exit from the college?

- a. Vocational Certificate
- b. Advanced Diploma
- c. Bachelor's Degree
- d. Associate Degree

Answer : b

Answer: B

Solution & Explanation:

The NEP 2020 introduces a flexible multiple entry and exit system for higher education undergraduate degrees (3 or 4 years). The certifications are structured as follows:

- Exit after 1 year: Certificate
- Exit after 2 years: **Advanced Diploma**

- Exit after 3 years: Bachelor's Degree
- Exit after 4 years: Bachelor's with Research

Since Reshma exits after completing 2 years, she is legally entitled to receive an Advanced Diploma.



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
