Explanation



- **Statement 1 is correct** - The Netra Airborne Early Warning and Control (AEW&C) System is India's first indigenously developed airborne early warning system.
- It was developed natively by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO).
- It aims to strengthen the Indian Air Force's air defence capabilities, early threat detection, and real-time battlefield situational awareness
- **Statement 2 is correct** - The system is mounted on the Brazilian-made Embraer EMB-145 aircraft.
- It features an indigenous AESA radar, enabling simultaneous detection and tracking of multiple aerial targets.

2) The PM-RAHAT scheme aims at which one of the following?

Answer : c

Explanation

- It aims to lower India's Maternal Mortality Rate (MMR) to below 70 per 1 lakh live births by 2030.
 - Reduce the Neonatal Mortality Rate (NMR) and the Infant Mortality Rate (IMR).

5) which one of the following is not a khariff crop?

- a. Paddy
- b. Jowar
- c. Wheat
- d. Copra

Answer : c

Explanation

- **Option c is correct** - Wheat is classified as a Rabi crop.
- It is sown during the winter season (typically October to December) and harvested in the spring (March to May).
- It thrives in cooler climates and requires controlled irrigation rather than heavy monsoon rains.
