- **Statement 1 is correct** - Marburg virus disease (MVD) is a severe, rare, and often fatal viral hemorrhagic fever that affects both humans and non-human primates.
- It has a very high case-fatality rate.
- **Statement 2 is correct** - Egyptian fruit bats (*Rousettus aegyptiacus*) are generally considered the natural reservoir hosts for the Marburg virus.
- These bats can carry the virus asymptotically and transmit it to humans, often through contact with bat excrement or infected cave/mine environments.

3) The Lok Operating System (LokOS) is an initiative of which one of the following?

Explanation
